

Midbrain, Pons, or Medulla Oblongata?

Objective: Review the functions and locations of the three parts of the brain stem

How to play: Students use the PearDeck application to move their dot to the part that matches the statement read aloud.

Statements:

Controls eye movement and other visual and auditory reactions (midbrain)

The middle part of the brain stem (pons)

Part of the brain stem closest to the forebrain (midbrain)

Controls most involuntary actions (medulla)

Controls breathing (pons)

Part of the brain stem that connects to the spinal cord (medulla)
